MV: Don't you believe that contemporary art, which is founded upon the principle of subjectivity, is radically different from the ancient one?



II. FLASHBACK ART FAIR

The first edition of Flashback was born in 2013 in Turin. Year after year other chapters followed making up the whole story. Each year Flashback's tale grows up and renews itself. For each new edition, a new form is conceived and transformed into its cornerstones.

In 2024, Flashback Art Fair titled its twelfth chapter **equilibrium?** proposing a reflection on the idea of balance, commonly associated with stability and harmony, but here placed in a critical light. The fair asks whether a balance is always fair and desirable, or whether it conceals repression and inequality, social, economic, geopolitical.

III. WHERE AND WHEN

Turin is the place.

It is the most educated and radical centre in Italy. It is at the forefront of cultural welfare and the economics of knowledge. It is a laboratory town, with the most dynamic citizens in the European Union. Here, the seeds of the future come to light from the dialectics between the city-centre and the suburbs. Turin is dedicated to the arts. Indeed, Turin's art week is recognised as one of the most vibrant events in the world, thanks to the presence of several initiatives and activities, each one with its own specificity. Flashback Art Fair is a highlight of this remarkable week, as it is the only event representing art from the early years to the present day, encompassing ancient, modern and contemporary art.

IV. FLASHBACK HABITAT

Flashback Habitat is a 20 000 m² independent arts center where art and life are linked in an indissoluble pair, an Ecosystem for Contemporary Cultures. The aim is to design a free space for socio-cultural enjoyment where individual self-realisation is combined with acting in solidarity for a community.

The art center is located in a large park a few minutes far from the historic center of Turin, the complex is made up of 4 pavilions:
the pav. A dedicated to local artists and associations;
the pav. B dedicated to exhibitions;
the pav. C dedicated to conviviality with Il Circolino which hosts the bistrot, talks, videos, Lab for children and a sound program;
the pav. D, still a work in progress...


